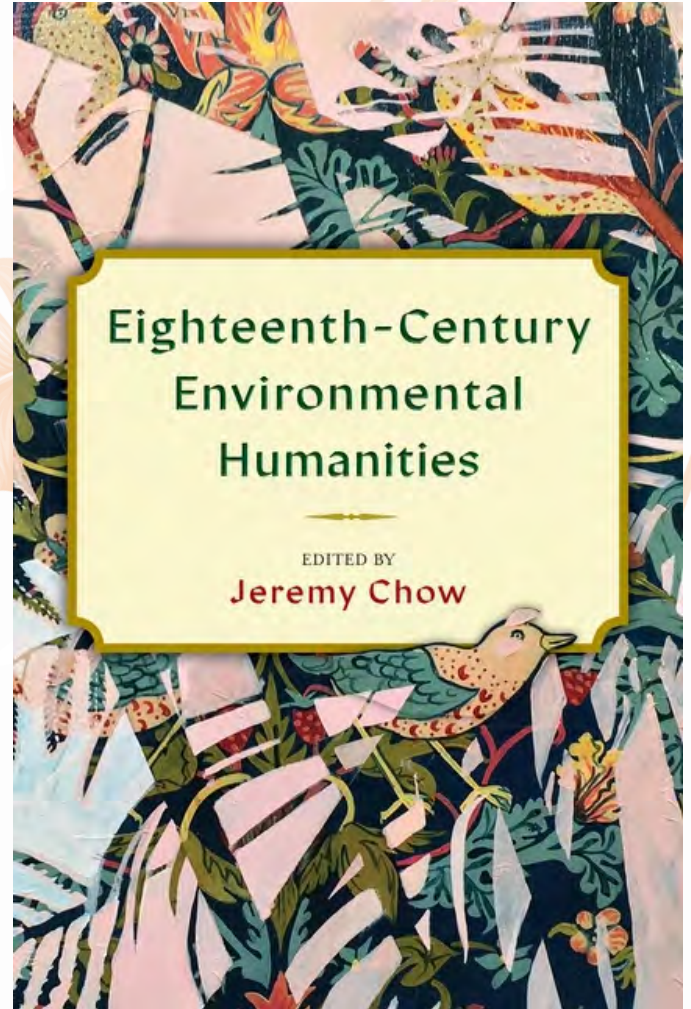
Eighteenth-Century Environmental Humanities
